

The USS SLATER: During World War II, 563 Destroyer Escorts battled Nazi U-boats on the North Atlantic protecting convoys of men and supplies. In the Pacific, they stood in line to defend naval task forces from Japanese submarines and Kamikaze air attacks.



The USS Slater Museum on the Hudson River in Albany is the only restored World War II Destroyer Escort afloat in the United States. The USS SLATER has undergone an extensive restoration that has returned the ship to her former glory. The museum offers hour-long guided tours.

The USS Slater is located at the intersection of Broadway and Quay St, on the Hudson River in Downtown Albany.

USS SLATER MUSEUM PASS BORROWING POLICY

Museum passes may be borrowed by Easton Library cardholders who live in the Library district and are 18 years of age and older. Passes may be checked out for a 3-day period. Pass must be returned to the library desk, DO NOT place in book drop. ***There will be a \$5.00 per day fee for any pass returned after the 3-day period. There will be a \$60 replacement fee for a lost museum pass.*** The museum pass will allow admission for 2 adults and 2 children.
